Your staff team were wonderful and made us feel very much at home, they are a credit to you and you can see their dedication to the success of the young people in their care.

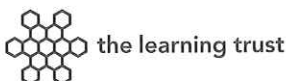
We would be honoured if you could visit our school here in London, England and we could extend the same hospitality to you and your staff.
